- A Science Fair project should have a Question, Hypothesis, and an Experiment to answer the question. It is not just a "project"

- There are four categories you can choose from in doing your project: Biology, Technology, Earth Science, and Physical Science
- Projects will be judged on: Creativity Ability, Scientific Thought, Skill and Thoughtfulness, Clarity and Dramatic Presentation, and Overall Presentation. Judges will be from outside Swift Creek. No one at Swift Creek will be a judge.
- You will be present with your project to answer any questions for the judge as they visit your project. You should be able to explain and demonstrate anything you did while doing your science fair project. No parents will be allowed in during the judging.
- Certificates, Ribbons, and small prizes will be awarded to 1st place, 2nd place, 3rd place, and 4th place in EACH grade level. Award Ceremony will be held Thursday at 1:30 in the gym and announced Friday morning.
- Your projects will be displayed and viewed in rotations during Science Day.
- Projects will need to be removed at the end of the school day on Friday April 20th.
