

Math Standards Review – Open for Public Comment through April 20

The North Carolina *Standard Course of Study* provides a guide to instruction, emphasizing what students should know and be able to do as they progress through various levels of proficiency and ultimately exit from high school. Every five to seven years the North Carolina Standard Course of Study is revised. The revision process for K-8 Math began at the state level at the beginning of the 2016-2017 school year. Teacher leaders and content experts from across the state drafted the first version of the standards and sent this draft to local districts for review in January/February. Our district process enabled all teachers to offer input into the revision of the standards. The district compiled feedback from our staff and submitted that feedback to the Department of Public Instruction.

The Department of Public Instruction recently released Draft 2 of the Math Standards for public review, along with a survey to allow the public to provide feedback. You can access both Draft 2 of the Standards using the link below:
